

Instructions for individual quilts featured in Sew Simple Pineapple Plus by Karin Hellaby

Pineapple Jazz Quilt (*backcover*)

Light batiks - ½ yard from each of two fabrics

Gold - ½ yard

Black - ½ yard

Tan/red - 1 yard also used in binding

Grey - ¾ yard

Border - ¾ yard

Make 16 pineapple blocks using the four triangle technique on page 10 in Pineapple Plus by Karin Hellaby. Stitch the blocks together as shown in the quilt photograph with a ½" seam.

First border Cut 1¾" strips in grey and attach with a ½" seam.

Final border Cut 5" strips in tan flower fabric. Stitch with ¼" seams. Attach side borders first. Make four cornerstones using the four triangle technique to round 2. Trim the four blocks to 5". Measure top and bottom of quilt and attach one to each end of top and bottom border strips

Pineapple Plumes Quilt (*page 3*)

Blue Batik - 1¼ yards

Pink - 1 yard

Turquoise - ¾ yard

Cream - 1 yard

Dark cream - ¼ yard (centre blocks fabric)

Make 8 pineapple blocks in blue/mauve and 8 pineapple blocks in blue/turquoise using the four triangle technique on page 10 in Pineapple Plus by Karin Hellaby

Stitch the 16 blocks together as shown in the quilt photograph with a ½" seam.

First border Cut two 1¾" strips in cream and attach with a ½" seam to quilt sides. Cut two 1¾" strips in cream, adding mauve cornerstones (1¾" squares) and attach with a ½" seam to quilt top and bottom.

Final border Cut two 4½" strips in blue fabric. Stitch with ¼" seams to quilt sides. Cut four 4½" cornerstones in turquoise and stitch to each end of two more 4½" strips in blue fabric. Stitch to quilt top and bottom

Bubble Gum Quilt (*page 5*)

Fabric required : One Layer Cake (approx. 36 10" squares) and 1½ yards navy blue fabric.

Make 12 pineapple blocks using the four triangle technique on page 10 in Pineapple Plus by Karin Hellaby. Stitch the 12 blocks together as shown in the quilt photograph with a ½" seam.

First border Cut four 2¾" strips in navy and attach with a ½" seam to quilt sides.

Final border Cut 2½" x 2½" rectangles from Layer Cake fabric. Stitch together along short sides to make four borders. Attach pieced borders with ¼" seams to quilt sides.
